**Colossians 3:12-17**

All of us have \_\_\_\_\_ and \_\_\_\_\_ in life and some of those choices and decisions lead to \_\_\_\_\_. While we are not able to experience all of the disasters in life, God gives us the \_\_\_\_\_ to fortify us and keep us from some of the things in life that bring us \_\_\_\_\_. The word of God is not just a bunch of \_\_\_\_\_ to keep the Christian from "having fun." Living holy is a set of life \_\_\_\_\_ that protect us and keep us from hurt, harm, and danger, especially emotional hurt, harm, and danger. Colossians 3:12 Therefore, as God's \_\_\_\_\_ people, holy and dearly loved, \_\_\_\_\_ yourselves with compassion, kindness, humility, gentleness and patience.
